Flea Treatment Prep Sheet



Treatment:

One-time treatment which utilizes Linalool, an extremely low toxic adulticide, and an IGR (insect growth regulator) for long-term control.

Expectations:

Treatment results: 95% of fleas are eliminated within the first hours of treatment. The remaining 5% die over the next 30-45 days.

Warranty:

After 45 days the re-treatment warranty becomes valid and continues through the end of February of the following year. If the preparations are not completed, the warranty will not be considered valid. **Warranty is void if carpets are shampooed after treatment and/or veterinary-approved flea treatment for pets is not maintained.**

Preparation Instructions:

1. People and all pets must vacate for 2 hours.
 - Fresh-water aquariums should be covered and air pump turned off. Salt-water aquariums may require additional care. Consult a marine professional prior to treatment.
2. Pick up all loose items (including items on closet floors, under couches and cushions, under beds). Do not place items on furniture.
3. Vacuum all floors using a rug “beater bar” or power head vacuum. Vacuum beneath beds and in closets. Also vacuum any upholstered furniture where pets frequently lay or play. This must be done within 8 hours PRIOR to treatment. Discard vacuum bag in an outside trash receptacle when finished.
4. Dispose of non-washable pet bedding.
5. Clean and vacuum dog house.
6. If carpet is to be shampooed, it must be done two days PRIOR to treatment and thoroughly dried.
7. Treat all dogs and cats with a veterinarian approved IGR product (i.e. Frontline, Advantage.) Periodically retreat pets according to veterinarian recommendations.

After Treatment

1. Upon returning, open all windows to aerate house.
2. Uncover aquarium and turn on air pump.
3. Keep home heated at 65 degrees or more for a minimum of 2 weeks after treatment
4. Vacuum once more within 24 hours after treatment and when any flare-up of fleas occurs, especially if home is left vacant.
